Inspired by love, kindness, and the teachings of Christ, GPA is committed to transforming lives spiritually, socially, and economically.

Mission Statement:

To transform lives through love and kindness, teaching orphans, street kids, widows, and vulnerable people to embody Christ-like values and find freedom from poverty in Jesus' name.

Vision:

- To bring glad tidings to the poor.
- To proclaim liberty to captives.
- To transform lives spiritually and financially.
- To return repentance and remission of sins to believers and non-believers.

II. ACTIVITIES AND ACHIEVEMENTS IN 2019

1. Youth Evangelism Program

In its founding year, GPA introduced an innovative approach to evangelize and transform the youth. The program was conducted in two main ways:

• Sports Evangelism:

GPA organized regular sports events to attract youth participation. After the games, Gospel messages were shared, sparking impactful conversations about salvation and faith in Christ.

• Church-Based Evangelism:

In 2019, GPA effectively utilized **\$25,000** to implement its programs. The funds were allocated as follows:

- Youth Evangelism Program: \$15,000 (Sports events, church-based evangelism, and discipleship programs)
- Community Engagement and Support: \$5,000 (Outreach programs in Nakivale Refugee Camp)
- Administrative Costs: \$5,000 (Staff salaries, logistical support, and operational expenses)

GPA remains committed to financial transparency, ensuring that every dollar contributes directly to transforming lives.
